 - Strengthen evidence-based decision-making using local and global benchmarking approaches.

ABSTRACT

This full-day interactive workshop provides participants with practical experience in analysing maternity datasets to support quality improvement and clinical decision-making.

Through facilitated discussion of selected, de-identified datasets, participants will explore data interpretation, data quality, and local clinical context. Each dataset is considered individually, with a focus on understanding how structured classification can support meaningful clinical insight.

The workshop will focus on applying the Robson Ten Group Classification System as a structured framework for evaluating caesarean section rates and broader perinatal indicators.

Participants will move beyond theory to practical implementation, examining how maternity data can be used to inform service planning and support evidence-based improvements in care.
